ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be 18 years or older.

VISA INFORMATION

Student visa not required: participants may enter the U.S. on a tourist visa (or visa waiver).

ACCOMMODATIONS

Students are responsible for arranging their own housing and meals during their stay in Hawai'i. On-campus housing availability is limited; you may also want to explore off-campus housing options.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Students must have medical insurance during their stay in the NICE program.

FEE

Total fee is \$1,255 (\$1,155 course fee and \$100 non-refundable application fee).

Additional fees may be required for optional activities.

CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY

\$100 application fee is non-refundable; 100% of course fee is refundable for cancellations made by 2 business days prior to program start. No refund thereafter.
