

Executing on HPU's campus master plan to be a centralized urban campus with Aloha Tower Marketplace as the anchor, over summer 2019, the University moved into new space at Waterfront Plaza and acquired additional space at Pioneer Plaza.

Is HPU done with campus moves?

Almost. Over May and June 2019, the University completed the majority of its campus consolidation project, opening new facilities at Waterfront Plaza. HPU attained additional space at Pioneer Plaza for the College of Professional Studies and administrative departments, which join the College of Business. HPU is actively planning for the buildout of Natural Science lab spaces at Waterfront Plaza, and the University anticipates completing these labs in one to three years.

New myHPU Mobile App

The user-friendly mobile app offers a multitude of helpful features, including a campus map and interactive student services, providing students a quick way to see their schedules and to look up classes. The new mobile app is available for download on the Apple App and Google Play stores.

At Waterfront Plaza – in the back of Building 6 at the corner of South Street and Ala Moana Boulevard – there is a large grassy area, which HPU students, faculty and staff are welcome to enjoy. It's a perfect spot to socialize, eat lunch, study or relax.



4. New shuttle stop locations

Effective fall 2019, the downtown shuttle will drop off at Bishop Street at Aloha Tower Drive; drop off and pick up at Aloha Tower Drive at Piers 5 & 6; and pick up at Aloha Tower Drive (near Irwin Park, opposite the hula girl statue).



5 Over 350 parking spaces for mopeds and bicycles

The University constructed a new moped parking area at Piers 5 & 6 with 150+ spaces for students, on top of the 150+ spaces located at HECO. Additionally, there are 50 moped spaces near Pioneer Plaza at the racks located on Fort Street Mall in front of Ross. For a fee (\$3 per 30 minutes), there is limited moped parking available at Waterfront Plaza.
